

Adult passport book (age 16+) \$110.00	Child passport book (under age 16) \$80.00	*Passport card (under 16) first-time applicants \$15.00
*Passport card (age 16+) first-time applicants \$30.00	Expedited Fee (faster) \$60.00	Express Mail Fee \$14.96

↪ Passport card may not be used to travel by air! It will facilitate entry at U.S. land and sea ports-of-entry when arriving from Canada, Mexico, the Caribbean and Bermuda
