

GRADUATE STUDENT STIPEND 2024



The Elizabeth D. Rockwell Center on Ethics and Leadership at the University of Houston will offer stipends to incoming graduate students beginning in the fall of 2024 in the amount of \$4000/year. Students will be awarded the stipends based on their potential to produce exemplary scholarship on ethics and leadership in their chosen field of study. Students who are awarded these stipends will be expected to attend EDR Center events when possible, and normally to meet as a cohort once per semester to share ideas and seek constructive feedback from one another.

Academic departments will forward qualifying applications to the Elizabeth D. Rockwell Center for consideration. Students might indicate in their applications if they wish to be considered for this stipend (usually on top of other funding).
