Consent in the Dark: Sexual Ethics in a Post #MeToo World

What does consent look like in action? In this talk based on the recently released collection, *Unsafe Words*, sociologist Trevor Hoppe argues that the tools such as "enthusiastic consent" are tailored to the experiences and needs of (mostly White) heterosexual people. In search of a more expansive vision of sexual ethics, Professor Hoppe explores homegrown tools that queer communities use to practice ethical sex and reflects on his own experiences as a gay man to consider strategies for preventing and responding to sexual violence.
