This list is not exhaustive and is subject to change. It provide examples of common events and the minimum event security expected. There are other factors that may cause a need for additional event security, including the presence of alcohol, cash handling, open admission, bag checking, dignitaries or attendees of public interest as well as other factors that may be specific to the venue, nature of the event or requesting group. The appropriate level of event security will be discussed in advance of the event with the requestor.

Event Type	Definitions
Concerts	a public performance, such as music or dancing, given by one or more artists
Conferences	a formal meeting for discussion, learning, and/or planning around a common interest
Seated Food Function/Dinner	a function in which there is defined seating that includes a program/ceremony with a set order of events
Pageants	a public entertainment event consisting of people in elaborate costumes/outfits, performances, and/or music
Showcases/New Member Presentations	an entertaining show introducing an organization's newest members to the public and campus community
Social Event/Dance/Mixer	a group of people gathered together to socialize, including music, activities, and/or networking
Walks/Runs	an organized event that coordinates a group of people to run/walk a predetermined course
