

SECTION 27 3000 – VOICE COMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT

PART 1 - GENERAL

1.1 RELATED DOCUMENTS

 - 2. Voice Communications Equipment shall be Owner Furnished, Contractor Installed (OFCI).
