Alexander Obregon is the Regional Vice President of Finance & Business Operations, serving as the Chief Financial Officer for Comcast Texas. In his current role, Obregon is responsible for Comcast Texas's financial planning and reporting, capital management, business assurance, and the project management office. He also leads the business operations functions of supply chain, fleet, real estate, and facilities.

Prior to his appointment, Obregon served as Deputy City Controller for the City of Houston and Chief Operating Officer for the Office of the City Controller.
