

Be Well to Do Well with a Preventive Health Checkup!

HR POWER UP Employee Wellness has partnered with BlueCross Blue Shield of TX (BCBSTX) HealthSelect and Catapult Health to bring no-cost Preventive Health Checkups to the University of Houston! **Preventive <u>Health Checkups</u>** will be conducted on campus **Monday, April 7; Tuesday, April 8; and Wednesday, April 9, from 8:30 AM to 3:30 PM, in the Student Center South, second floor Heights Room 224**. Active employees enrolled in the HealthSelect of Texas[®] or Consumer Directed HealthSelect[™] plan who have not had a routine physical/preventive screening completed in the last 12 months are eligible to participate. If you are enrolled in the HealthSelect of Texas plan, you must have a PCP on file with BCBSTX to receive in-network benefits. Having a PCP on file ensures you will not be charged for these services.

New this year: If you have a Kelsey-Seybold PCP on file with BCBSTX, you now ARE ELIGIBLE to participate in a Catapult checkup!

On-campus appointments take less than 30 minutes, and each check-up includes over ten important measurements including cholesterol, hemoglobin A1C, triglycerides, blood pressure and more. Scheduled at your convenience, your health check-up will be followed by a one-on-one video consult with a board-certified nurse to review the results of your screenings. You will then be given access to a secure patient portal to view your comprehensive personal health report and action plan.

Eligible participants must have their BCBSTX medical card with them and are asked to wear clothing that allows for easy access to the arm. While fasting is recommended, it is not required to receive these screenings.

There are two incentives to participate in this preventive health check-up. Your participation in the on-site Preventive Health Checkup will count as the physical exam requirement for <u>Wellness Leave</u>, and you will receive a \$50 reward in the new <u>Buena</u> <u>Vida portal</u>!
