## **Resolution in Support of the 2012 Transgender Day of Remembrance**

**Whereas**, The 2012 Transgender Day of Remembrance will be held in the A.D Bruce Religion Center at the University of Houston on November 17th 2012, and

**Whereas**, The University of Houston LGBT Resource Center will be hosting the 2012 Transgender Day of Remembrance, and

**Whereas**, The 48<sup>th</sup> administration of the University of Houston Student Government Association passed the SGA Resolution 48004 calling for implementation of the Gender Expression Non Discrimination Act; and

Whereas, The Transgender Day of Remembrance is a time of reflection and serves as a symbol of respect for many University of Houston students who identify as transgender and genderdiverse, raising awareness of the adversity many transgender individuals face; and

Whereas, In Houston, transgender individuals are routinely denied employment, social services and medical care, and emergency homeless shelters routinely refuse to house transgender individuals; and

Whereas, There is a history of violence, discrimination, and homicide among members of the Houston transgender community; and

Whereas, The Transgender Day of Remembrance was set aside to memorialize those around the world who were killed due to anti-transgender hatred or prejudice, and

Whereas, Since the year 2000, Houstonians have observed the Transgender Day of Remembrance as a way to give the LGBT community and allies a chance to honor the memory of those whose lives were cut short as a result of ignorance and hate while bearing witness to the suffering that anti-LGBT bigotry inspires; and

Whereas, This is the 13th year of observance in Houston;
