SGA resolution recognizing RAs' hard work

Whereas, Resident Advisors (RAs) serve a very important leadership role by setting an example for other students in their residence halls and managing a University residence hall floor of ethnically diverse students attempting to promote community development, resident interactions and campus involvement;

Whereas, an RA can have a significant impact on his or her residents' college experiences, especially if these residents are freshmen;

Whereas, UH is an increasingly residential university, making the role of RAs ever more important;

Whereas, RAs who create positive experiences for their residents will encourage more students to reside on campus;

Whereas, the position of RA involves a great deal of effort, involving many hours of dedication per week, staying on call overnight, and a general expectation of being available 24 hours per day, 7 days per week;

Whereas, RAs are counseling students on various personal and academic problems, leading a learning community, resolving resident conflicts and dealing with incidents involving facilities;

Whereas, RAs often get minimal recognition outside of the Student Housing & Residential Life department.

Therefore, be it resolved be the 50th Administration of the Student Government Association of the University of Houston:

That The Student Government Association would like to recognize and thank RAs for their hard work and encourage them to play an active role in students' lives.

Be it further enacted that SGA believes RAs deserve more recognition around the campus, and thus other institutions at the university should show their appreciation.
