Attorney General Appointment Amendment

Whereas, the Title III, Article 7, Section 5, Clause 1 of the Bylaws of the Student Government Association state that the Attorney General "shall serve until he/she is no longer a student at the University of Houston, or is no longer in good academic or disciplinary standing with the university",: and

Whereas, we believe each president should have the freedom to appoint his or her own Attorney General: and

Whereas, the Student Government Association, in the interest of facilitating the business of the Department of Justice, would avoid a situation in which an Attorney General might matriculate the semester prior to entering the election and disrupt the support to the Election Commission;

THEREFORE LET IT BE ENACTED by the 51st Administration of the Student Government Association of the University of Houston:

That the University of Houston Student Government Association amends the following clause of the Student Government Association Bylaws to:

Title III: The Executive

Article 7: The Department of Justice

Section 5: Appointment of the Attorney General

Clause 1: The Attorney General shall be appointed by the President with advice and consent of two-thirds (2/3) of the senate members present and voting, and shall serve for the duration of the administration.
