## **Opposition of Creation of Compulsory Auxiliary Services' Fees**

Whereas, auxiliary services at the University of Houston have been established as distinct and mutually exclusive entities of the university; and

Whereas, these auxiliary services were established to be self-sufficient and financially independent entities; and

Whereas, approximately seventy percent of the student body at the University of Houston receives need-based financial aid and is consequently highly sensitive to the proliferation of new compulsory fees being leveraged upon them; and

Whereas, an avenue to pursue the funding by Student Service Fees already exists in the form of the Student Fees Advisory Committee; and

## **THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the 51<sup>st</sup> Administration of the Student Government** Association of the University of Houston:

That this body opposes the creation of any new and distinct compulsory fees for the purpose of funding any University of Houston Auxiliary Services.
