## **Original Jurisdiction Authorization**

Whereas, Issues have arisen in the past that required the judiciary to act unconstitutionally to maintain order and,

Whereas, a temporary solution can easily be applied until constitutional changes take effect.

Therefore be it enacted that the 52<sup>nd</sup> Senate of the Student Government Association of the University of Houston:

Authorize that the Chief Justice shall have the authority to create a temporary court to cover issues not relating to the constitutionality of an issue.

**Be it further enacted,** that the temporary court must be approved by the President and Speaker of the Senate.

**Finally be it enacted,** that this legislation shall expire after the referendum for Ballot Measure 52001 is completed.
