## Parking and Transportation for Weekday Athletic Events

Whereas, students and members of the campus community have a diverse set of commitments, responsibilities, and extracurricular activities which requires their presence on campus and,

Whereas, individuals pay a premium to access generally available, convenient and expedient parking and,

Whereas, permit holders agree to the provision of their space for special events throughout the year when purchasing their permit, as is stated in the parking rules and regulations and,

Whereas, students and faculty expect the university will not commit to special events that have the effect of making general and garage permits ineffective and useless, and

Whereas, these expectations and requirements were not met on Thursday, October 8, 2015 during the UH Football game and,

Whereas, the university also has a commitment to fostering a nationally-recognized athletic program.

## Therefore be it resolved by the 52<sup>nd</sup> Student Government Association of the University of Houston:

That the University of Houston Parking and Transportation Services, as a preliminary act of good faith in finding tenable solutions for similar parking conflicts in the future, should rescind and reimburse citations for permit holders who received the following violations on Thursday, October 8, 2015, during the UH Football game:

- V3: Parked curbside; with the exception of cars parked on a sidewalk or in a construction area
- V4. Parked overtime at a parking meter
- V7. Parked in a lot without the proper decal/permit for that lot
- V8. Parked in or blocking a driving lane
- V10. Parking on the grass; with the exception of blocking a sidewalk or crosswalk
