"Freedom Day' Acknowledgement

Whereas, July 4<sup>th</sup> is not an accurate Freedom Day because many minorities, most inclusive to African Americans were not free that day. June 19<sup>th</sup> is the official Freedom Day for all Americans;

Whereas, this day, Freedom Day, commemorates the ending of slavery in the United States. In the year 1865, it was on June 19<sup>th</sup> that Union soldiers arrived at Galveston, Texas with news that the war had ended and that the enslaved were now free. This was two and a half years after the Emancipation Proclamation was implemented on January 1<sup>st</sup>, 1863;

Whereas, Juneteenth was officially the Freedom Day for all Americans.

Therefore, be it resolved by the Student Government Association of the University of Houston:

That the University of Houston should recognize June 19th, 1865 "Juneteenth' as an officially observed Holiday;

Be it further resolved, that the holiday be put on the University of Houston calendar for recognition purposes.
