The Straw Initiative Resolution

Whereas, the University of Houston is committed to increased sustainability in its five-year strategic plan;

Whereas, the World Wildlife Organization reports that plastic as a result of single-use plastic items "has been found in an estimated 90% of all seabirds and in all sea turtle species... [as well as] within the next decade, there could be a pound of plastic for every three pounds of fish in the ocean.^{*1}

Whereas, the University of Portland – Oregon has been the first University in the United States to successfully ban plastic straws, with many other colleges and universities following suit; ²

Whereas, a phased transition to a plastic straw-free campus would be in support of the University of Houston's Auxiliary Services' goals for long-term sustainability at on-campus dining facilities, in partnership with Chartwells;

Whereas, based on the results of a random survey created by the Student Life Committee of 197 University of Houston students, 81.7% reported wanting a plastic straw-free campus and 75.1% being in favor of using paper straws.

Therefore, be it resolved by the Senate of the Student Government Association of the University of Houston:

That the Student Government Association of the University of Houston resolves to support this "Straw Initiative", which will involve a phased transition to an eventual removal of all plastic straws at all on-campus restaurants and dining areas;

Be it further resolved, that the Student Government Association is willing to work with Chartwells to explore alternative straw options that are conscious to students with disabilities.
