Whereas, the University of Houston aspires to be a national leader in diversity, equity, and inclusion¹;

Whereas, the University of Houston has received the Higher Education Excellence in Diversity (HEED) Award for its outstanding commitment to diversity and inclusion²;

Whereas, students at the University of Houston have differing gender conformities and gender identities that are recognized by the university³;

Whereas, the University of Houston Student Government Association represents students of the LGBTQIA+ community;

Whereas, The University of Houston Student Government Association recognizes the need for all students to comfortably address others and be addressed by their respective pronouns;

Therefore, be it enacted by the Senate of the Student Government Association of the University of Houston:

Be it further enacted, that Title 2 (6) (1) (2), of the Bylaws be added;

Be it further enacted, that Title 2 (6) (1) (2) read; "Members of the Student Government Association must include their pronouns next to their names in SGA related meetings held virtually. Those who refuse to comply or include pronouns in an inappropriate manner will face removal."
