Repair, Improve, and Clean Agnes Arnold Hall Resolution

Whereas, Agnes Arnold Hall is the center of the University of Houston campus and one

of our best-known buildings;

Whereas, Agnes Arnold Hall has 32 classrooms and 184 offices;

Whereas, Agnes Arnold Hall houses various CLASS departments, including: African

American Studies, Hispanic Studies, India Studies, Chinese Studies, History, Modern

and Ancient Languages, Philosophy, and Women-Gender-Sexuality Studies;

Whereas, Agnes Arnold Hall houses the Dean of the College of Liberal Arts and Social Sciences;

Whereas, departments that are housed at Agnes Arnold Hall issue hundreds of degrees every year;

Whereas, grass, crabgrass, moss, and other plants grow on the walkways of the building.

Whereas, paint on the ground and first level are chipping, exposing previous layers;

Whereas, HVAC does not work on multiple floors. Specifically, within the interior

rooms for African American Studies, Modern and Classical Languages, and Women-

Gender-Sexuality Studies departments;

Whereas, Elevator 3 of Agnes Arnold is supposed to be repaired by January of 2022 but construction has not started;

Whereas, hateful posters and stickers that call for violence generally and against other

University of Houston students specifically are not properly removed;

Whereas, the wooden desks are too small for comfortable use by most students. Furthermore, many are breaking after years of use;

Therefore, be it enacted by the Student Government Association of the University of Houston:

The Student Government Association supports and calls for immediate improvements, repairs, and cleanings of Agnes Arnold Hall to facilitate an adequate leaning and working environment for CLASS students and faculty.

Be it further resolved, that wooden desks are replaced with those in use in the lecture halls of Agnes Arnold Hall.

Be it further resolved, that HVAC is fixed in the upper levels of Agnes Arnold Hall.

Be it further resolved, that various surfaces including the floors, walls, fire hatches,

elevators, and railings are repainted to beautify and cover graffiti.

Be it further resolved, that the Elevator Repair Project receives adequate support to complete its goal.

Be it further resolved, that groundskeeping frequently cleans windows, removes webs and plants, and clean trash from the vine beds on the ground level.
