Supporting Higher Wages for Lower-Income Campus Staff

Whereas, University of Houston pays staff based on a paygrade scale from 104-114, with 104 being the lowest level of pay offered¹;

Whereas, the University of Houston's minimum wage is \$8.00/hour for student workers and \$13.00 for university staff;

Whereas, from 2020 to 2022, the U.S. Consumer Price Index for all items in the market basket increased by 13.5 points²;

Whereas, many student leaders and staff work positions on campus, which generally necessitate overtime without pay in order to adequately fulfill the responsibilities of the role;

Whereas, as a Tier-One University, the University of Houston should offer a competitive salary that is comparable or better than current market value.

Therefore, be it resolved by the Senate of the Student Government Association of the University of Houston:
