Not raising student fees, just raising cap. Currently a \$250 cap on student fees, this measure will allow increases up to \$270. SFAC may recommend and the UH Board of Regents may approve up to a 10% increase in student fees. This cap will allow them to increase no more than \$20 for the next Fiscal Year. UH is growing and the need for more student services is present. The last time this issue was reviewed was 5 years ago, when the cap was increased to \$250.
